The Forest School Practitioner position is a full-time position.

## The Forest School Practitioner will:

- 1. have an in depth understanding of the physical, social, emotional and language development of pre-school children.
- 2. understand the importance of learning through play and be able to successfully balance the two to provide structure when needed.
- 3. Be a key worker for a group of children
- 4. Maintain accurate and detailed records of the children to include: daily documentation of the child's learning, observations and learning journeys
- 5. intuitively identify children's interests and connect them with the tools and equipment to help achieve their passions and goals.
- 6. believe in empowering children to take ownership of 'risky' activities and help other staff identify creative ways to make that happen.
- 7. be excited about helping children explore their own interests and creativity using a wide range of resources including technology.
- 8. organise the term/year plan to include trips and projects
- 9. provide opportunities and a safe environment to challenge the children's understanding of the world and the environment
- 10. encourage curiosity and a sense of wonder and adventure
- 11. encourage and provide opportunities for questioning
- 12. facilitate engagement with high quality well planned activities, experiences and resources
- 13. broaden children's understanding and support their development in the 7 key areas of the Early Years Foundation Stage
- 14. Undertake such other duties and responsibilities of an equivalent nature as may be determined by the Management Team.
